~ DRAFT COMMUNITY GARDEN GROUND-RULES ~

1. All our community gardens are maintained organically; which means no chemical fertilizers, herbicides or pesticides are allowed.
2. Respect private property and each other.
3. Have something planted in your plot by June 15, or it will be reassigned.
4. If you must abandon your plot for any reason, please notify the garden coordinator (Jeff 905-342-2320).
5. If your plot becomes unkempt you will be given two weeks notice to clean it up. After that time it will be reassigned or tilled in.
6. Do not pick or take other people's harvest. Treat others as you would like to be treated. Help others by letting them know if they have produce ready to harvest; do not do it for them. If you do not know their phone number let us know and we will contact them for you.
7. Keep garden plots neat and preserve the property from vandalism and debris.
8. Keep the garden in a good state of cultivation; weed frequently and water as necessary. Do not waste water; mulching will prevent water waste and keep your garden vigorous.
9. Operate motor vehicles with extreme caution. Park in designated areas. Do not leave vehicles overnight at the garden site. They will be towed.
10. Supervise children at all times.
11. Help and cooperate with general garden work at the site. You are responsible for your own clean up. Dispose of litter, recyclables and compost in the proper locations.
12. Take the responsibility for harvesting your own crops. Failure to remove crops and debris by October 31 will result in your plot being tilled under.
13. Please no alcohol consumption on the grounds of Northumberland Heights. However, you are welcome to stop in the restaurant/bar for a drink and great eats!
